



Obtaining a Property & Casualty License in Georgia

Qualifications

1. Must be at least 18 years old
2. Resident of Georgia
3. Successfully complete a 40 hours pre-licensing insurance course. **This 40 hour prelicensing course is now available online** (www.examfx.com).

If you do not want to take the licensing course online you have the option of attending a classroom course that is available in various ways to meet your needs and schedule. Getting Started – 6 Easy Steps

1. Upon completing the 40 hour pre-licensing course (online or classroom) you will be given a multiple choice test. A score of 70 or better is passing.
2. Upon passing the test you will receive a certificate showing completion of the class along with a copy of your test results.
3. Next, complete a “Resident Insurance License Application (Georgia Form GID-103). You can obtain a copy of this form by going to the following website:

4. Along with the application you’ll also need to include copies of the following:
 - Course certificate showing completion of the 40 hour class.
 - Copy of test results
 - \$75
5. In a few weeks the Department of Insurance will send you your Property & Casualty license.
6. Once you receive your license, Georgia law requires that you also complete an agency license form (Georgia Form GID-130). **This form is required only if your business is not a sole proprietorship.** This is a form to register your company (corporation, LLC, etc...) with the Georgia Department of Insurance. This does “**not**” require taking a test. When you register and submit the completed application you will also need to include a one time fee of \$50.
